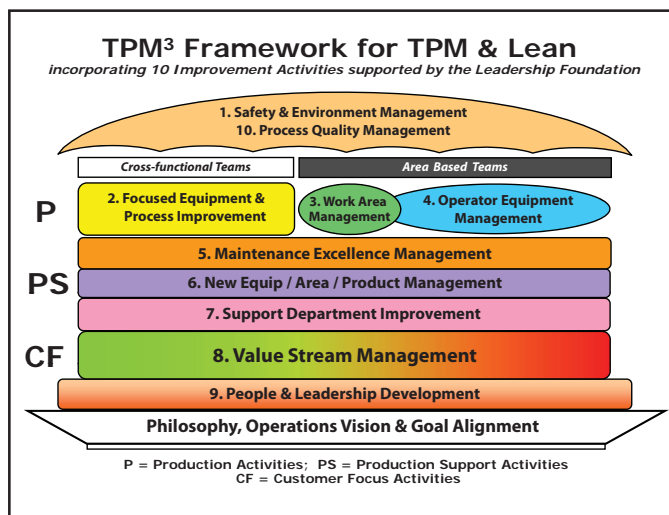

Competitive Manufacturing Qualifications aligned with our TPM & Lean (TPM³) Methodology

Our unique approach links the training and assessment for Competitive Manufacturing Certificate III and IV to our TPM & Lean (TPM³) journey, thus allowing:

- Employees, once enrolled to be assessed for the required units while they are either Team Members (Cert III), or Team Leaders (Cert IV) of TPM³ Teams.
- Employees to be formally recognised with a National Qualification as they contribute to the company's strategically driven improvement initiative, rather than just complete a series of often ad-hoc projects to satisfy their training requirements.
- Practical assessments in the workplace rather than post training assessments in the classroom

TPM & Lean (TPM³) is a holistic approach to improvement ultimately involving all employees. As such all employees within the factory or office can complete the qualifications

CSR Ethanol Yarraville (VIC)



CSR Ethanol is one of three leading Australian producers of ethanol products. They began their TPM³ Journey with CTPM Australia in January 2008.

In September 2008, the Yarraville site enrolled 2 students in CTPM Nationally Recognised Training. They are currently undertaking Certificate IV in Competitive Manufacturing Qualifications aligning with CTPM's TPM & Lean (TPM³) methodology.

Midland Brick Company (WA)



Midland Brick is a large clay brick manufacturer. As part of the Boral Group, Midland Brick has expanded its building product range far beyond bricks and pavers to become part of the largest building products manufacturer in Australia. In September 2008 they commenced their TPM & Lean (TPM³) Journey with CTPM.

In May 2009 they decided to enhance their Journey with the enrolment of 100 students for the Nationally Recognised Competitive Manufacturing Training Program. They are successfully working towards the completion of some of the certificates in 2010.

B&D Doors Revesby (NSW)



B&D Doors have been Australia's market leader in the manufacture and marketing of garage doors and automatic openers since 1958.

In February 2009 B&D Doors commenced their TPM & Lean (TPM³) journey. They initially enrolled 18 students in the Nationally Recognised Competitive Manufacturing Training Program and by the end of 2009 had a total of 47 students enrolled.

All employees have enrolled in a formal traineeship program through MAS National Apprenticeship Centre, with a majority of the employees qualifying for the funding assistance provided from the Federal Government.

Sugar Australia Glebe (NSW)



Sugar Australia is the leading supplier of quality refined sugar products. They service the industrial and consumer sugar market and market the CSR Sugar brand.

In February 2009, Sugar Australia's Glebe Island site, enrolled 20 of its 25 employees in Competitive Manufacturing Qualifications that are aligned with CTPM's TPM & Lean (TPM³) methodology.

13 of the employees are progressing towards their Certificate III and 7 towards Certificate IV in Competitive Manufacturing through a formal traineeship offered by MAS National.

Bega Cheese Bega (NSW)



Bega Cheese has been a dominant brand in the Australian market for over 30 years in both processed and natural cheddar cheese products. Today, it continues to process and distribute the highest quality dairy products, to both Australian and international markets.

In November 2009, 25 employees from the Bega Cheese site in Bega undertook a one-day Frontline Problem Solving Workshop. During the workshop and in the weeks after while in the workplace the students completed their assessments aligned with the Competitive Manufacturing Unit MSACMT280A – Undertake root cause analysis.

All 25 employees have now successfully completed their assessments and received Statement of Attainments for all their hard work.
